


Explore Prosser's Hiking and Walking Trails

Hiking in Prosser, Washington, offers a picturesque experience **where the Columbia Valley unfolds in every direction**.

Explore the winding trails of the Horse Heaven Hills, which provide sweeping views of the valley below as the Yakima River snakes through it. Or, enjoy the 15 miles of paved pathway that stretch from Prosser all the way to Sunnyside.

Along the way you'll be greeted by, **views of the rolling hills dotted with sagebrush and the distant Cascade Mountains**, including glimpses of Mt. Adams and Mt. Rainier. Whether you're an outdoor enthusiast or a casual walker, Prosser's trails and pathways offer a delightful opportunity to get outdoors.
